Mumps

We have one case of mumps in our school. It is caused by a virus and it affects mainly the salivary glands, especially the parotid gland which lies in front of the ear; other glands can also be involved.

The incubation period is about three weeks. Your child may feel unwell for one or two days beforehand, but a swollen and tender parotid gland is usually the first sign. One side often swells up a day or two before the other and sometimes one side only is affected. Please take your child to the doctor should these symptoms be present.

Hat, Hair and Nail Inspection – Term 3

Please ensure that your son's hair is cut during the holiday and is short, neat and ready for the new term. Girls' hair must be neat and should be tied back, if it touches the collar of the shirt.
