SGB By-Elections

A By-Election Notice was sent out on 8 August informing parents/guardians of the By-Election Meeting for the nomination of a nominee for a parent member of the Governing Body of Laddsworth Primary School. The By-Election will be held on **Thursday, 22 August at 07h30** in the **Media Centenary Centre**.

Nominations for this position can be made on the prescribed forms prior to, or on the morning of the meeting, but we ask that their proposers and seconders are present with them at the SGB By-Election.

Should the required 15% quorum (126 parents) not be met at the first By-Election meeting on **Thursday, 22 August at 07h30**, the meeting will be postponed to a second meeting. The second meeting will take place 7 days later on **Thursday, 29 August 2019 at 07h30**, in the Media Centenary Centre, where no quorum will be required.

Both parents are eligible to vote. It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to ensure that their names are on the school's Admission Register, which can be viewed at the school. (Only parents whose names are on the school's Admission Register / Voter's Roll will be entitled to participate in the School Governing Body by-election.) Parents must please ensure that they have their Identity Documents with them when arriving, so that this can be validated against the voters roll.

Nomination Forms are available from Mrs Jager, at the Administration Office.

Candidates (who must be parents/guardians of learners at the school and who are not employed at the school) may be nominated by submitting to the Electoral Officer a nomination form, duly completed by the candidate and his/her proposer and seconder. The nominee, the proposer and the seconder **must** be parents/guardians of learners at the school. The Nomination Form must be returned to the school at least one day before the elections are conducted. Nominations will also be accepted at the Nomination and By-election Meeting. (The proposer, seconder and candidate **MUST** be present at the nomination meeting.)
