MySchool app is live in the App Stores. They have upgraded the app to include a **Virtual Card which you can scan in Woolworths stores**. The book holding partners (Waltons, Spur, and Wimpy) also use the app. Please note when you open the app it should give a written card number and the scan card. This means one less piece of plastic in your wallet. Never forget your card at home again! Plus the app informs people of our partners and helps people change their beneficiary easily and quickly (people still supporting their old school can quickly change to our organisation or add you to their profile).

KZN Athletics Sub-Youth Championship
